2nd Annual Run and Roll for the Dole 2 Mile Family Friendly Fun/Health Walk



The City of Crystal Lake, the Crystal Lake Park District, the Village of Lakewood, and Lakeside Legacy Arts Park are partnering in "Run and Roll for the Dole" on Sunday, October 17, 2010. The Duathlon includes a 2-mile run and a 20-mile bike race, followed by another 2-mile run. The race is offered to individuals, teams, and corporations. This year Lakeside Legacy is pleased to offer an option of a 2-mile walk. Registration opens at 6:30 am with the race start time

at 8:00 am. Pre-registration and additional information is online at LakesideLegacy.org. Entry fees are \$35.00 for individuals and \$75.00 for teams, and \$15 for walkers age 12+ (kids under 12 are free for the walk if they participate with a parent/guardian.) All proceeds benefit the Lakeside Legacy Foundation and the renovation of the Historic Dole Mansion. Awards will be given by age group, team, and corporate challenges. As part of the corporate chal-

lenge, Crystal Lake Mayor Aaron T. Shepley has issued a challenge to all Cities, Villages and Towns in Illinois to take on his team in this historic race. The race will start and finish on the grounds of the Historic Dole Mansion near the shores of the beautiful Crystal Lake. The running course will wind through streets surrounding the Dole Mansion, while the bike course will take competitors through the Village of Lakewood.

The Sinful Saints Dixieland Band has been entertaining the people of Northern Illinois and Southern Wisconsin since founder Tom McDermott first pulled this crew together in 1994. A decade and a half later, the Saints are still tearing up parties by bringing their unique blend of music and showmanship to thousands of eager listeners. The Saints play music from the heyday of Dixieland, tunes that were first heard nearly a hundred years ago. They also play traditional jazz from the 20’s and 30’s as well as some music from Dixieland’s Revival in the 1950’s. If it Stops, Floats or Struts, the Saints are probably playing it!
